Today 26 March 2021, a meeting was held at the office of Resources Safety & Health Queensland (RSHQ) Level 5, 44 Nelson Street Mackay. Representatives participating in the meeting were from Moranbah North Mine and the Mines Inspectorate.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the mines actions undertaken to address the current Directive pursuant to section 167 of the Coal Mine Safety and Health Act 1999, given on the 21/02/2021. The Directive was given for a suspension of re-entry into the mine until such time as the SSE can demonstrate an acceptable level of risk.
